Worldview Mission (WM) is a nonprofit global organization connected to the United Nations and affiliated with a multitude of organizations in the world that are concerned with ending poverty. The United States is an accumulation of many ethnicities, religions, and cultures which makes it the ideal place to commence our awareness programs. Although the United States is one of the richest counties in the world, still, 37 million people are poor, and from those 13 million children (19 percent of all children) under age eighteen live in families with incomes below the official poverty threshold. That is the principal reason that the WM is on a mission to break the cycle of poverty in low economic communities by educating and preparing the youth to become leaders in their community and eventually extend their cause on a global level. Poverty effects the education of our children, but education is a viable and effective means to end poverty. Poverty is caused by a myriad of circumstances from which many are outside the realm of control for those living in poverty and those who endeavor to end it. Our programs are therefore directed to enhance selfdirection, self-determination and self-regulation of our youth as oppose to just giving them a handout which constitutes merely an ephemeral solution but not a solution to the problem.

Our Mission


To eradicate poverty in our communities and provide a safe haven for those in need. It is our goal to improve the quality of life for the people living in poverty by helping them to become self-sufficient.


