# NATIONAL INDIVIDUAL CONSULTANT - YOUTH COORDINATOR FOR THE UNITED NATIONS MILLENIUM CAMPAIGN AFRICA OFFICE.

The Africa Regional Office of the United Nations Millennium Campaign will be extending the contract of the above named person for a period of six months from 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2013 to 21<sup>st</sup> January 2014

## **BACKGROUND:**

The Youth Coordination Desk is geared towards the formation of a regional movement bound by the mandate of Millennium Development Goals as a way of fostering the betterment of the lives of the youth in the region.

The binding principle is that of mutual respect for one another despite cultural, political or economical differences and Unity on basis of consensus for progressive development of the region, with the creed "Nothing for us without us" as a guide, form the governing point for the Youth Desk.

### **OBJECTIVE:**

- 1. To mainstream youth groups in the advocacy on MDGs Campaigning in Kenya and Africa;
- 2. To promote the build-up of a Peoples movement for MDGs gaining in strength and power;
- 3. To support African Youth and organizations in their efforts towards the acceleration of attaining the MDGs in the region through creation of partnerships and sharing of ideas and resources;
- 4. Expand the knowledge base of MDGs and improve practice on advocacy and lobbying campaign;
- 5. To promote the monitoring and evaluation of Government policy and practice to increasingly fulfill MDG entitlements;
- 6. Build on already existing networks while establishing an effective communication network for youth within and outside the African region;
- 7. Enhance the scaling up of citizen monitoring for MDG entitlements at the local level.

- To develop and implement an outreach programme for the promotion of Huduma in the context of the devolution process;

- To develop and establish popular public platforms of engagement around socio-economic issues and inequalities;
- Develop and implement a youth outreach programme for the promotion of My World proposal.
