ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURES

All participants must arrive on Sunday, 22nd June and depart on Thursday, 26th June 2014. Please provide us with your *flight details* along with your *registration number* (given to you on your official invitation letter) before **Friday, 13th June 2014** to ensure timely airport transportation. Kindly note that there will be buses and vans taking you from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) to Melaka, scheduled according to the flight details that is given to us by you. For smooth execution, please make sure, that you inform us promptly about your arrival time.

Late confirmation may not allow us to receive you at the airport.

AIRPORT PICKUP

International participants will be picked up from both airports, the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) and the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) 2 and transported to Permaisuri (MITC) Hotel in Melaka, Malaysia.

MIYD Organizing Committee will be waiting for you at the arrival hall, after customs and immigration, with a welcome placard with WAY and MIYD logo. You are advised not to move to the arrival hall too quickly, as you may miss the placard. Local participants, i.e. those residing in Malaysia, will need to make their own way to the meeting venue or meet the organizing committee at KLIA. If you are lost or need any assistance please contact the emergency contact numbers of the Organizing Committee given below.

REGISTRATION FEE

All foreign participants are required to pay a registration fee of U\$150 and all local participants (resident in Malaysia) should pay RM450. This fee can be paid in advance or at the MIYD venue. Only registered participants with confirmation letters issued by the time of the application deadline (30th May) will be allowed to attend the dialogue.

We would like to inform all of you that places are now fully booked and no further registrations are accepted.

ACCOMMODATION, FOOD AND LOCAL TRANSPORT

All participants will be accommodated in **Permaisuri (MITC) Hotel**. Note that the accommodation is twin-sharing in all cases.

Participants who want to upgrade to single-occupancy rooms should pay an additional U\$150 for the period of 22nd to 26th June 2014.

Also for those arriving early or departing late, an additional fee of U\$50 per standard room per night will apply. The hotel contact details and map are indicated at the end of this document.

Food shall be provided according to the prescribed menu. Provisions will be made for those needing vegetarian, Halal or any other special food. Kindly notify us upon registering at the MIYD venue.

WAY will cater for the accommodation, food and local transportation for all accredited participants.

HEALTHCARE

Vaccines and medicines¹

Please note that people from countries where the **yellow fever card** is required alongside your other travel documents should remember to bring it along. As stipulated by the Ministry of Health of Malaysia, failure to present the yellow fever card, will result in a mandatory 6 day quarantine.

All travelers

You should be up to date on routine vaccinations while traveling to any destination. Some vaccines may also be required for travel.

Routine vaccines

Make sure you are up-to-date on routine vaccines before every trip. These vaccines include measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine, diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccine, varicella (chickenpox) vaccine, polio vaccine, and your yearly flu shot.

Most travelers

Get travel vaccines and medicines because there is a risk of these diseases in the country you are visiting.

Hepatitis A	CDC recommends this vaccine because you can get hepatitis A through contaminated food or water in Malaysia, regardless of where you are eating or staying.
Typhoid	You can get typhoid through contaminated food or water in Malaysia. CDC recommends this vaccine for most travelers, especially if you are staying with friends or relatives, visiting smaller cities or rural areas, or if you are an adventurous eater.
