





Briefing on the Global Thematic Consultation on Governance and the Post-2015 Development Framework

From October 2012 through March 2013, the Governance consultation provided a platform to discuss governance and accountability bottlenecks in the context of the MDGs. The consultations consisted of a series of regional meetings in Africa, the Arab region, Latin America and the Caribbean, and Asia, as well as an expert meeting on measurement, e-discussions, and a final meeting at the Pan-African Parliament in Johannesburg, South Africa. Throughout the consultation, a strong consensus emerged among participants on the relevance of governance as a foundation for sustainable development. The Briefing will present the consultation's outcomes at the UN Headquarters in New York, as a contribution to the intergovernmental processes on Sustainable Development Goals and the Post-2015 development agenda.
