AIWW Conference Sessions:

An open call for papers attracted over 175 submissions, each of which has been peer-reviewed. Papers have been selected by the Programme Committee based on reviews to ensure high quality presentations for this conference. These papers will be presented in 80 minute sessions comprising of 3-5 presentations of 15 minutes which includes Q&A between the audience and presenters (10 min presentation, 5 min questions and answers). Additional instructions for session chairs & presenters

For session chairs

- Refer to the latest conference programme to confirm the date and time of the session that you are moderating. [Programme URL]
- If your session is in the morning, please pick up the speakers detailsfor your session from the speakers room (located Room G 107) during the morning tea break.
- If your session is in the afternoon, please pick up the speakers details for your session from the speakers room during the lunch break.
- Please arrive at the session room at least 10 minutes before the session start time to meet with the presenters, and to familiarize with the room setup.
- During your session, a member of the secretariat team will be present in the room to provide technical assistance if required.
- Please exercise diligence in time keeping, and ensure sessions start and end on time.

For oral presenters

- Refer to the latest conference programme to confirm your presentation date and time.[Programme URL]
- If you are presenting in a **session**, submit your powerpoint presentation via a USB stick to the secretariat team at the speakers room the day before your scheduled session. The speakers room will be open from Monday, November 2th after the IWW opening Ceremony. If you cannot submit prior to your session, please contact the conference secretariat (aiwwprogramme@iwahq.org) and send them your powerpoint presentation via email. Please also print and bring along your brief bio-data.
- If you are presenting in a **workshop**, please provide your powerpoint presentation to your workshop organizer directly.
- Arrive at the session room at least 15 minutes before the session start time to meet the session chair, and to familiarize with the room setup.
- Keep to the time allocated for your presentation. You are encouraged to keep your powerpoint slides to a maximum of 10 slides. Please be concise in your delivery.

For poster presenters

- All posters will be displayed in the **Topaz lounge and infront of the G rooms**
- Size of posters: Height: 120 cm and width: 80 cm
- Please bring the hard copy of the poster with you to the conference
- Presenters can put up their posters onto the display board from Monday 2 November 13.00 hrs onwards on date. Presenters are reminded to bring along their own velcro or adhesive tapes for putting up their posters.
- Please put up the poster on the correct poster display board according to the serial number, poster name and author(s) indicated on the board itself.



5. Information on the conference dinner on Tuesday 3 November 2015

The conference dinner will take place at the Amsterdam Wharf Tuesday 3 November from 19.00 – 22.00 hrs. The Amsterdam Wharf, being the former historic lifeboatstation, situated just east of Central Station has been carefully crafted into a unique and versatile venue. There is a shuttlebus tot the conference dinner and back to the RAI. The bus will leave at the end of the dinner 22.00 hrs. The Warf is a 10 minute walk to the Amsterdam Central Station.

8. Excursions

During the International Water Week, several excursions will be organized. The excursions take place on Monday 2, Thursday 5 and Friday 6 November.

Directions to the RAI Amsterdam

The venue for the IWW Conference is RAI Amsterdam (Entrance G, Europaplein 2-22,

1078 GZ Amsterdam). The conference will take place in Rooms G102 – G111 (see Annex 1)

(1) By train

The RAI has its 'own' station, RAI Amsterdam which is located a stone's throw from the RAI complex and is easy to reach from anywhere in the Netherlands. When leaving the station, follow the signs

for RAI Amsterdam. For further information, you can consult the NS [Dutch railways] travel planner by visiting: www.ns.nl.

(2) By tram, metro or bus

Tram 4 runs between the RAI (Europaplein stop), Amsterdam's city centre and Amsterdam Central Station. You can reach the RAI from the Amstel railway station by taking Metro 51



and Bus 65. Metro 51 also runs to Amsterdam Central Station. Metro 50 runs regularly between the Amsterdam Sloterdijk and Gein stations and stops at the RAI Amsterdam station.

(3) By car

The RAI is immediately signposted on roads signs on the ring road drivers end up on after approaching Amsterdam from the A1 motorway (Amersfoort/Amsterdam), the A2 (Utrecht/Amsterdam) or the A4 (Den Haag [The Hague]/Amsterdam). RAI Amsterdam is situated right next to the ring road (Exit 9). The RAI's car parks are signposted immediately after leaving the ring road.

(4) From Airport

Amsterdam Airport Schiphol is located a mere 15 minutes from RAI Amsterdam whether you travel by car, train, taxi or bus. The <u>Schiphol.nl</u> website provides specific information including: up-to-the-minute flight information, connecting transport facilities to RAI Amsterdam and business facilities.
