Our research focuses on the challenges and opportunities in strengthening response to climate change on multiple levels of governance in India and the EU. We wish to provide for a better understanding of climate action emerging from the bottom-up at lower levels of governance such as federal states, cities and municipalities, and the interplay and consistency with climate policy frameworks coming from the national and supranational level.

### **Important information:**

Unpublished research papers (papers/posters) are to be submitted to ICCCR 2015 conference. Submitted papers will be reviewed by the conference technical committee. The abstracts should not exceed 300 words and should be based on the sub-themes or issues related to climate change resilience. The abstracts and full papers are to be sent electronically to **[icccr2015@gmail.com](mailto:icccr2015@gmail.com)**.

Both the abstract and full paper should be word processed using MS-Word, Times New Roman, font 12 with double line spacing. The abstract should be followed by five key words. The full paper should not be more than 15 pages including the title, main text, tables, Figures, photographs and references. The references should adopt the APA style (<https://owl.english.purdue.edu/owl/resource/560/01/>). The first page should be used to indicate the title, name(s) of the author(s), e-mail address and telephone (GSM) number, along with the registration information.

Selected papers are likely to be brought out in an edited volume.

### **About the venue:**

Pondicherry is well connected to Chennai and the nearest airport is the Chennai city airport at a distance of 160 kms. The Tamil Nadu State and Pondicherry Transport Corporation operates Volvo air-conditioned and ordinary bus services from Chennai to Pondicherry via ECR more frequently.
