Our Concern



- ❖ There are important gaps in the “Critical Milestones toward Coherent, Efficient and Inclusive Follow-Up and Review at the Global Level” (SG Report, 1/2016)
- ❖ Reviews should not become top-down big-data expert driven instead we suggest to balance SDGs implementation with bottom up monitoring by a country’s citizens and communities
- ❖ Institution are key actors in service delivery and oversight. HLPF thematic reviews of SDG 16.6, SDG 16.7 and SDG 17.9 must be scheduled in **2016 not in 2019!!.**

What are these Primary SDG Targets?



SDG 16: Promote just, peaceful and inclusive societies

16.6 Develop **effective**, **accountable** and **transparent institutions** at all levels

16.7 Ensure **responsive**, **inclusive**, **participatory** and **representative decision-making** at all levels

What are the Primary SDG Targets?



SDG 17: Revitalize the global partnership for sustainable development

Capacity Building

Target 17.9 Enhance international support for implementing effective & targeted capacity building...to support national plans (Partnership Agreement) including through North-South, S-S and triangular cooperation

What are these Primary SDG Targets?



Target 17.18 (2020) increase significantly the availability of **high-quality**, **timely and reliable data** **disaggregated** by income, gender, age, race, ethnicity, migratory status, disability, geographic location and other characteristics **relevant in national contexts**

Target 17.19 (2030) to develop **measurements of progress** on sustainable development that complement gross domestic product, and **support statistical capacity-building** in developing countries



Monitoring

- Is part of the ***due diligence*** for the people, by the people and of the people
- Needs to be structured for regular review and analysis
- Must support local learning and innovation

Is NOT something nice to do!
But MUST do now!

Next Steps



- Agreeing on a common **monitoring framework** to ensure process predictability (rules, policy and procedures)
- Setting up a **governance mechanism** to ensure the quality, compatibility, inclusiveness and steady flow of data
- Co-investing in a **global monitoring infrastructure** including regional data hubs to pool all structured or unstructured data for public access and meta analysis
- **Linking existing databases** to support SDG review **at all levels**
