The occasion was a brief, exciting and impacting one as the participants were thrilled by an article on peace presented by Miss Ezeuduji Oluchi on behalf of the club as an eye opener to what we were commemorating—*The International Day of Peace*.

Following this was a charge by the president of the club, Master Ejeguo Ogheneovo. The president also elucidated on the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) and the post 2015 agenda where he enjoined all participants to be active players in realizing the MDGs, with emphasis being laid on MDG 7(maintaining a sustainable environment). He highlighted the importance of trees while making specific mention that trees help to clean the atmosphere and make the air safe by absorbing about 40% of CO₂ that is being released daily. He concluded by saying that the planting of trees would be commenced around the school as soon as the provost of the college endorses the club's request.

On the sub-theme: Youth, Peace and the Future, the key note speaker, Barrister Nwankwo quoted **“if we joke with peace, then violence will joke with us”**. He also emphasized that

peace is possible and attainable, however, the youths will continue to be in conflict until the economic structure of our society (Nigeria) puts the youths into consideration citing their use as machineries of war.
